Dear Families,

Vancouver Public Schools values your feedback! This May, we will be asking you to take a brief survey to tell us about your experience with Vancouver Public Schools. To ensure we continue to provide high quality, rigorous learning experiences that meet the needs of our learners and prepare them for college and career, we need your feedback. We want to know what you think.

To administer this survey, we have partnered with Panorama Education to conduct our 2022 Family Survey. Panorama safeguards your privacy, keeping your responses anonymous. The survey will be available to complete starting on May 16, 2022 and close on May 27, 2022. You will be able to take the survey online at home, from a computer or on your phone. On the morning of May 16, you will be emailed the link to complete the survey. You may also access the survey on the Vancouver Public Schools website at <https://vansd.org/sel/>, or your student's school website. The survey should take approximately eleven minutes to complete and must be completed all at once (you will not be able to answer a few questions and save to complete at a later time). You will have the option to complete a survey for every child in your home (for example if you have a child in elementary school and a child in middle school, you can complete a survey for each child's school).
